

PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO BFA DEGREE COURSE FOR THE YEAR 2019-20

G.O (Rt)NO.778/2019/HEDN Dated, 20/05/2019 Thiruvananthapuram,

1 Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree Course is introduced for those who have passed +2 or equivalent examination to acquire degree in Fine Arts. The selection will be made on the basis of an Entrance Examination. The duration of the course is 4 years. The 1st year of the course is termed as common course and the remaining 3 years are allocated for specialization in Painting, Sculpture and Applied Art in college of Fine Arts ,Thiruvananthapuram and Mavelikkara and specialization in Painting,Sculpture, Applied Art and Art History & Visual studies in college of Fine Arts,Thrissur. These specialized branches in the 2nd year will be offered based on the percentage of marks obtained in the 1st Year University Examination and the options exercised by the student in the ratio 1:2:3, Sculpture: Painting: Applied Art. (In the case of College of Fine Arts, Thrissur, the ratio will be 1:2:3:1, Sculpture: Painting: Applied Art: Art History & Visual Studies.) First and Final year examination will be conducted by the Universities to which the colleges are affiliated while the 2nd and 3rd year Examinations by the respective Colleges.

2 Institution and Intake

- a. College of Fine Arts, Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram- 695 033 affiliated to University of Kerala with intake of 43 students +1seat. *
- b. Raja Ravi Varma College of Fine Arts, Mavelikkara- 690 101 affiliated to University of Kerala with intake of 40 students +1seat.*
- c. College of Fine Arts, Thrissur- 680 020 affiliated to University of Calicut with Intake of 47 Students + 1seat.*

***1 supernumerary seat (over and above the sanctioned intake) in each institution is reserved exclusively for the candidates from the Union Territory of Lakshadweep vide GO (Ms) no: 53/2019/HEDN, dated 7.03.2019.**

3 Eligibility

- a. Candidates must have passed +2 or equivalent Examinations.
- b. Candidates should have completed 17 years of age and must below 27 years as on 1st June 2019.

4 Reservation of Seats

- a. Seats are reserved for Candidates belonging to socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC) belonging to Kerala State as per GO (Ms) No.683/2015/H.Edn. Dated 11-12-2015. The distribution of seats for various categories is as follows. Ezhava- 9%, Muslim-8%, Latin Catholic and Anglo Indian-3%, Other backward Christian-1%, Other Backward Hindu-3%, Kudumbi-1%, Kusavan and related communities-1%, Dheevera and related communities-2% and Viswakarma and related communities-2%. Candidates claiming reservation under SEBC quota should produce self attested copies of Non- Creamy layer Certificate and income certificate from the Village Officer concerned and self attested copy of community certificate from the revenue authority along with the hard copy of application form. However, all candidates who are considered for any fee concession/ scholarship/ any other benefits based on annual family income should produce Income certificate from the Village Officer concerned at the time of admission.
- b. For Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) Candidates belonging to Kerala State, the reservation of seats is 8% and 2% respectively. Candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST quota should produce self attested copy of the Caste/Community Certificate obtained from Tahasildar along with the hard copy of application form.

- c. 5% seats are reserved for Differently abled candidates. Candidates claiming reservation under this quota will have to attach a self attested copy of Disability Certificate from the District Medical Board to the effect that their disability is above 40% along with the hard copy of application form.
- d. One seat is reserved in any one of the institution for son / daughter of Ex Servicemen belonging to Kerala state. Candidates claiming reservation under this quota will have to attach a self attested copy of Certificate from the Military authorities concerned to the effect that he/she is the son/daughter of Ex- servicemen along with the hard copy of application form.
- e. The seats unavailed by the ST candidates will be allotted to SC candidates and vice versa. The seats unavailed by the SC/ST candidates will be allotted to candidates belonging to other Eligible Community.
- f. For the seats reserved for candidates from Lakshadweep, the following categories can be applied.

Category 1. Scheduled Tribe candidates from Lakshadweep.

Category 2. Native of Lakshadweep, not Scheduled Tribe (ST), but father or mother ST, passed Board/Higher Secondary/Plus two Examination from an institution in Islands or from the institution where his/her parent posted.

Category 3. Wards of employees (Not the native of Lakshadweep) working under Lakshadweep administration, passed Board/Higher Secondary/Plus two Examination from an institution where his/her parent posted.

All the three seats under this Category initially belongs to category 1, Vacant seats of Category 1 are given to category 2, if seats are lying vacant after allotment to Category 2, they are allotted to category 3. Any student from Lakshadweep qualifying and securing higher rank can claim open seat irrespective of category he/she belongs, including those who are in category 1, 2, 3. The applicants who claiming reservation under Lakshadweep Category should attach the self attested copies of the relevant Certificates in proof of their claim along with the hard copy of application form.

6 Application Forms

Application form, prospectus and guidelines for online submission of application form are available in

the websites: www.admissions.dtekerala.gov.in. Application fee is Rs.300/- for general candidates and Rs.150/-for SC/ST candidates, which can be paid in “**APPLICATION FEE ACCOUNT**” (**CURRENT ACCOUNT**) of **The Director of Technical Education at any branch of State Bank of India**.

7 Submission of Application

Applications are to be submitted through online and after online submission the print copy of submitted application along with self attested copies of other relevant certificates or documents in proof of candidate’s claims and bank chalan in proof of payment of application fee, should reach **The Director, Directorate of Technical Education, Padmavilasom Road, Fort P.O, Thiruvananthapuram-695023** by Registered post/ in person. Candidates should upload a passport size photo of the candidate in jpg/jpeg format of size between 15 to 30kb for online registration and affix the same photograph duly attested by gazetted officer in the space provided in the hard copy of the application form. The last date for the receipt of the hard copy of application is as per the schedule given in Annexure A.

8 Selection of Candidates

Selection will be made on the basis of an Entrance Examination (both written and practical) and an Interview.

8.1 Written Examination (Maximum 100 Marks)

(Region based Examination at GEC Kozhikode, College of Fine Arts, Trissur and College of Fine Arts, Thiruvananthapuram)

Subject: Objective type, Short essay, Reasoning ability, Mental ability, Imaging ability.

The candidate who secure 25% and above marks in written examination will be shortlisted for Practical examination.

8.2 Practical examination (Maximum 200 Marks)

(Centralized Examination at College of Fine Arts, Thiruvananthapuram)

The candidates will have to attend two Practical tests of 100 marks each.

Test1: Creative Painting (Water colour painting of given subject).

Test2: Life study drawing.

A minimum of 40% and above marks in both the practical examinations is required for a candidate to be short listed for the interview.

8.3 Interview (Maximum 100 Marks)

The candidates who have scored 25% and above marks for the written examination and 40% and above marks in the practical examination will be short listed for the Interview. The candidates attending the interview will have to bring their own creative works.

8.4 The candidate must bring pencil, colour and other necessary materials for the written examination and Practical examinations (papers including drawing sheets will be supplied by the department).

9 Rank List

Rank list will be prepared on the basis of Entrance Examination and Interview. Based on the institution preference of the candidates given in the application form, the selection will be made from above rank list. Reservation of seats as per Clause 4 will be followed in each institution and allotment will be made accordingly. The admission will be provisional and subject to the verification of the original documents by the Principal of the respective institution at the time of admission.

Any other details not specifically covered by the Clauses given in the prospectus will be decided by the undersigned and he/she is empowered to cancel any admission if found illegal and his/her decision will be final.
