ORDER

As per order read as 9th paper above, Government have accorded sanction for deputing the faculty members of Government & Aided Engineering Colleges for pursuing Ph.D (Final Admission) under Quality Improvement Programme for the year 2024-2025.

Under the circumstance, the faculty members shown in the list appended are hereby deputed for admission to Ph.D under QIP for the year 2024-2025, subject to the conditions stipulated in the Government orders cited above. All the faculty members who are deputed for Ph.D under QIP should execute a bond as stipulated in G.O. (Ms) No. 55/77/HEdn dated.12.04.1977, G.O. (Ms) No. 55/08/HEdn dated.24.05.2008 & G.O. (Ms) No. 317/10/HEdn dated.22.09.2010 in stamp paper worth Rs.500/-

(Rupees Five Hundred Only). The selected teachers who are already in the bonded period consequent on previous deputation should execute a supplementary bond along with the present one.

1. The format of the bond / supplementary bond is included as annexure.
2. Sponsorship certificate will be issued to the deputed faculty members only after verification and acceptance of the bonds submitted.
3. The deputed faculty members should furnish quarterly review progress report to the respective Principal of the College from where they are relieved.
4. On rejoining duty, the deputed faculty members should produce certificates from the respective QIP centers in proof of their successful completion of course.
5. Foreign journeys for paper presentation in connection with the deputation shall be performed only after obtaining prior permission from Government.
6. Requests for journey permission addressed to the Secretary to Government, Higher Education Department may be forwarded to the undersigned sufficiently early through the respective Principals.
7. The Principals should ensure that there occurs no delay in forwarding the journey requests of the deputed teachers to this Office, which are supported by a countersigned check list under appendix – I, the countersigned letter by which the teacher is invited for the foreign conference and the recommendation letter / NOC of the Guide / QIP Centre where the teacher is undergoing deputation.

expenses that shall or may have been incurred by the Government.

WHEREAS the Bounden has been selected for deputation by Government for higher studies for (here enter the name of course of study) at the, (here enter the name and address of Institution) for a period of Years with effect from (here enter the duration of deputation sanctioned by Government).

WHEREAS the Government have in their Order No. G.O. No. dated and as per Order No..... dated. of the Director of Technical Education has agreed to pay the bounden duringt he period of the said course an allowance equal to his pay and allowances which he would have drawn but for his undergoing the said course which the Government or Government of India or any other agency might give during the period of the said course and to treat then period of higher studies and the period of travel to and fro as duty and as service, qualifying for increment, leave and pension if it will otherwise count.

AND WHEREAS the Government have agreed to meet the said expenses on condition that after successful completion of the higher studies within the prescribed period allowed by the Government the bounden shall serve the Government in the Department of Technical Education for thrice the period of deputation/leave for study purpose sanctioned by Government as per G.O (Rt) No.

Dated and as per Order No. dated of the Director of Technical Education and also subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter appearing and the bounden and sureties have agreed to the same;

NOW THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE WRITTEN OBLIGATION IS THAT:-

In the event of the Bounden

- a) not conforming to the instructions regarding higher studies conveyed to him by the authorities concerned, or
- b) not conforming to the rules and discipline of the institute of higher studies or
- c) applying for any post or sitting any all India or State Government competitive Examination during the course of higher studies, or
- d) failing to intimate to the Government the amount and other particulars in respect of any honorarium or other monies earned by him during the period of his higher studies as above, or.
- e) refusing to hand over and surrender to the Government the whole or part of such honorarium or other monies received by him as aforesaid, as and when required or do so by the Government, or
- f) getting adverse report regarding the progress of his studies or regarding his conduct in and outside the place of higher studies, or
- g) failing to complete the higher studies successfully as aforesaid, or discontinuing the higher studies without the explicit prior permission of Government, or
- h) on completion of higher studies, failing to serve the Government for twice the period of deputation sanctioned by Government as per G.O. No. dated _____ and as per order No. _____ dated _____ of the Director of Technical Education continuously from the date of rejoining after QIP. i.e, if the deputation is for a period of 2 years, the bond period will be 4 years and if the deputation is for a period of 3 years, the bond period will be 6 years. But the bond period of the members of faculty who retire, will be completed on the date of their retirement, and such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Government, or
- i) failing to conform to the discipline of the Department or Organization of the Government or any Institute, organization or body selected by the Government where he is posted or
- j) failing to refund to the Government any over-payment made to him during the course of higher studies as aforesaid, or
- k) not conforming or observing the other rules and conditions subject to which he/she has been deputed for higher studies as per G.O (Rt) No..... H.Edn dated (here enter the number and

the date of the government order by which the deputation for higher studies has been sanctioned), and as per order No. dated..... of the Director of Technical Education the bounden and the sureties shall forthwith pay to the Government twice the amount of salary, stipend, DA, deputation allowance, tuition fees, scholarships, traveling expenses, study tour expenses etc he/she has drawn during the period of deputation along with 12.5% interest per annum as on the date of joining after availing deputation/leave for study purpose and the matter of deciding what monies are to be paid by the bounden and the sureties to the Government, the decision of the Government shall be final and legally binding on the bounden and the sureties and upon the payment of such sum the above written obligation shall be void and of no effect, otherwise this shall be and remain in full force and effect.

- I) The faculty who return after QIP deputation should register as a guide within two years from the date of award of Ph. D, failing which he/she should pay an amount of Rs.3 lakhs along with 12.5% interest/annum for every year up to the date on which he will register as a guide.
